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Galien Township Planning Commission Special Meeting August 22, 2018 7:30pm @ Galien Township Office Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm

SUP for Green Mitten:

See attached notes. J. Richter will get training info and total cost for the Sniffer. Also need to speak with Andy about completing the training and if he is comfortable being the one to administer the tests. After much discussion, the PC decided to table banning butane processing for now. We also decided to add a fine for non-compliance for odor control (fines to be set by township board). The township board will need to determine the amount of the policy for each applicant. J. Richter to check and see what other municipalities require and if it differs, based on the type and number of licenses. Add that no light shall be omitted from building to item 12. We need a baseline for Noise pollution and need to check the MIOSHA standards. The PC determined that hours of operation would not be limited at this time.

Jerry Mast: Jerry asked that we consider adding that the buildings must be steel to the SUP and suggested that we require concrete or asphalt from road for the driveways.

Joe Dickman: Joe asked where the 3ft berm would be located.

Ted Strefling: Ted wanted to be sure that fencing would be included on the site.

Ina Carr: Ina questioned what kind of building maintenance would be required.
